## Depression

If you have been referred to ReviveMed, it is likely that you are living with a major depressive disorder that has not responded to other treatments. You will likely have tried multiple SSRIs, SNRIs, Tricyclic or MAOI antidepressants, or anti-psychotic medication. You may be considering ECT or TMS.

Numerous studies at world-renowned institutions show that safe, low-dose infusions alleviate suffering in over 70 per cent of patients. Infusions can begin to work quickly, sometimes after just one or two treatments.

Infusions are delivered in a hospital environment, and the procedure adheres to the highest quality clinical design and delivery guidelines.

Each infusion is delivered by an anaesthetist who monitors the patient throughout.

Every infusion is tailored to the individual patient's requirements.

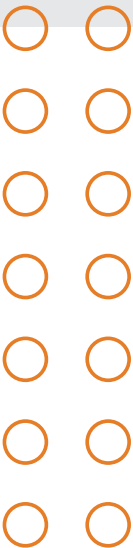
